HY Station is the ideal starting point to discover Malaga and Andalusia.


Located next to the María Zambrano train station, the bus station and the metro, our accommodation allows you to move around the city and to other Andalusian destinations with complete ease.

Ideal for nature, history and unique views.


Nerja

HOW TO MOVE

Public Transport to Malaga Center

BUS line 4/19/3/20 5 minutes from HY Station.
Metro L1 (Perchet) 4 minutes from HY Station.

Bus

At the Bus Station you will have connections with different cities in Andalusia such as Granada, Seville, Marbella, etc.

AVE and middle distance

AVE/long distance): destinations like Madrid, Barcelona, Seville, Córdoba, Valencia, Zaragoza, Granada and Alicante.
middle distance: destinations such as Granada, Seville, Córdoba, Antequera, Ronda, Bobadilla and Álora

Trip to the Historic Center of Malaga

From HY Station you will reach the historic center in a pleasant walk (20/25 minutes), where you will pass through Perchet Market, Soho, Port (Pier 1) before entering the historic center of the city.

Suburban train

It connects with towns in the interior of Malaga and you can also travel along the entire Malaga coast to Fuengirola.



GASTRONOMIC RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommendations Nearby HY Station

Breakfast: La Bella Cafe and La Ñora (huge sandwiches).

Lunch/Dinner: Meson Astorga, Elopizza and El Ladrillo Burguer and Camperos.

2 shopping centers less than 5 minutes away with a wide variety of both fast and more elaborate food.



Essentials in Malaga

Sardine skewers: Absolute star ideal in a good Chiringuito.

Fried Fish: anchovies, squid, pink fish, etc.

Gambas al pilpil: a must-try with a good piece of bread.

White garlic, Gazpacho and Porra Antequerana: fresh and very Malaga

Campero: Typical Malaga sandwich and a quick dinner.

Knitting with chocolate: more fatties and a top breakfast.



Some recommendations that you have to try:

El Pimpi: it is an essential classic (sweet wine, ham, cheese, sandwiches, etc.)

Casa Guardia: historic winery of Malaga sweet wine.

Meson Mariano: traditional you must try their porra antequerana, meatballs...

Atarazanas Market: Perfect for your daytime tapas (seafood, fried foods...)

Tintero: If you have time, come to El Palo and enjoy this experience.

RECOMMENDATIONS HY STATION

Escape to the El Palo neighborhood, enjoy its beach and Pedregalejo, and live the experience of eating at the El Tintero Restaurant or eating the best espetos in its many beach bars.

You can't leave without trying sweet wine/muscatel in typical Malaga taverns such as Casa del Guardia or El Pimpi, and tapas at the Mercado de Atarazanas.

Be sure to get lost in the streets of the center of Malaga, walk through C\ Larios, get lost among its streets and visit emblems of the city such as Alcazaba, Gibralfaro or the Roman Amphitheater.

See a sunset from the Port (Pier 1) or Gibralfaro Castle.

Be sure to visit one of its museums such as Picasso, Thyssen or Pompidou.

Enjoy the Malaga atmosphere: terraces, good weather and relaxed atmosphere.

Enjoy its coast, there are not only the beaches of its capital, you can find the best beaches on getaways to Nerja (Playa de Maro) or Marbella (Playa de Cabopino).
